Welcome to the NSO's 2022/23 season, by far our most ambitious to date. It is a season that aspires to welcome all musical tastes, present the most beloved classics, reflect upon significant issues in our history, and feature the best of Canada's talent.

The season begins with the Canadian Premiere of a new work co-commissioned by the NSO Harriet: Journey to Freedom, based on the life of Harriet Tubman, in a concert ending with the much-requested Tchaikovsky Symphony No. 4. Canadian talent abounds as we feature numerous Canadian works including Jared Miller's work for piano and orchestra, Shattered Night, reflecting upon the tragic Kristallnacht, Dinuk Wijeratne's Invisible Cities and Vivian Fung's Pizzicato. Rising star conductor Dina Gilbert makes her NSO debut, leading us through Dvořák's rousing Symphony No. 8, and the season concludes with Chickasaw composer Jerod Tate, Niagara's own piano virtuoso Jarred Dunn, and the first ever Niagara performance of Stravinsky's notoriously difficult epic, The Rite of Spring. Arguably my favourite program comes in late October with Jocelyn Morlock's Juno-award winning My Name is Amanda Todd, a work looking at a tragedy of very current relevance. This is paired with two works that welcome back Niagara favourite, soprano Claire de Sévigné: Barber's beautifully melancholy Knoxville: Summer 1915, and Mahler's 4th Symphony, which stunningly portrays a child's vision of heaven. This one is not to be missed!

As we embrace all musical tastes at the NSO, our 22/23 Pops season has something for everyone. If you love epic film scores, The Music of John Williams is back by popular demand. Over the holidays we begin a multi-season exploration of music from around the world with a Christmas Caravan featuring the Sultans of String. Early 20th Century jazz and swing features in our Big Band concert, and for the first time ever the NSO will be looking at 80's Pop music, exploring the beloved songbook of Phil Collins. As an added bonus, we are bringing back our tribute to the Tragically Hip, which was an instant sellout in 2020. This time we will be bringing it to the Avalon Theatre at the Fallsview Casino to ensure everyone will be able to get a ticket!

At the NSO we understand how important music is in your lives. As the price of everything rises, we will be absorbing inflation and keeping our ticket prices at 2021 levels. Music gives us joy and brings us together, and the NSO is committed to keeping that honoured tradition going.

Tchaikovsky Symphony No. 4

Stravinsky's early work with the *Ballets Russe* in Paris launched the composer to international stardom. The first of these works, *The Firebird*, is paired with Stravinsky's own childhood hero Tchaikovsky, whose thrilling Fourth Symphony depicts his struggle with Fate. Niagara's own Juliet Dunn joins the NSO in the Canadian premiere of Timothy Adams' *Harriet: A Journey to Freedom*, a co-commission honouring the life of Harriet Tubman and the local history of the Underground Railroad.

Jocelyn Morlock's JUNO Award-winning *My Name is Amanda Todd* tells the story of a bullied teen who boldly spoke up against cyber-bullying and harassment before tragically taking her own life. Canadian soprano Claire de Sévigné returns to Niagara to muse on the hazy melancholy of childhood in Samuel Barber's *Knoxville: Summer 1915.* Mahler's enchanting Fourth Symphony closes the programme with a child's serene vision of heaven.

Chickasaw composer Jerod Tate's *Chokfi'* portrays the titular trickster-rabbit from legend through tribal hymns and orchestral colours.


